Coach Mortensen is in her 15th year as the head coach at Adams State. Prior to coaching at ASU, she was the varsity coach at Cortez High School where her teams achieved a 60-0 league winning streak. She has been Southwest League “Coach of the Year” 7 times and also achieved “Colorado Coach of the Year” recognition by both the Denver Post and the Rocky Mountain News. In 2004, Mortensen was the national “Coach of the Year” nominee. At Adams State her teams have achieved winning records the last 9 of 10 years, qualifying for playoffs 10 years and in 2012 qualified for the NCAA tournament; the first time in program history!
